She competed with the Trinidad and Tobago National Cheerleading Team in 2015 at the International Cheer Union's World Cheerleading Championships in Orlando, Florida and was a competitor at the 2017 High School Worlds Championships with St. Joseph's Convent POS Scorpions'.

She is now a certified instructor with the Trinidad and Tobago Cheer Federation Instructor's Program 'Coaches U'. And presently is the Head coach for the Level 1 teams at St. Joseph's Convent POS Scorpions and Holy Name Convent POS Blue Jaguars.
