In 2015, she was selected for Trinidad and Tobago National Team and competed at the International Cheer Union's World Cheerleading Championships in Orlando, Florida.

During her 5 years coaching cheerleading, she has received national and international certifications, along with her instructor's training from prestigious sporting organisations like The International Cheer Union (ICU), the Universal Cheerleaders Association (UCA), and the International Gymnastics Federation, which has played a crucial role in her passion to help develop the sport of cheerleading locally.
